ONE: The name of this corporation shall be CITIZENS COMMISSION ON HUMAN RIGHTS.

TWO: The duration of this corporation shall be perpetual.

THREE: This corporation is a nonprofit public benefit corporation and is not organized for the private benefit of any person. It is organized under the Nonprofit Public Benefit Corporation Law for charitable purposes, lcs purposes are (a) to guard agair.st abuses of the fundamental rights of man as guaranteed by the Constitution of the United States and the Universal Declaration of Human Rights and, where such abuses occur, to seek their correction, (b) to encourage and support research into the effects of psychiatric and psychological practices and procedures, and into alternatives to such practices and procedures and (c) to publish materials regarding mental health, human rights and related areas, and to work with individuals and organizations on these issues en a local and national level.

FOUR: In the conduct of its activities and the accomplishment of its purposes, this corporation shall have, shall enjoy, and may exercise, to their fullest extent, all powers which nonprofit corporations are permitted by law to have and to enjoy; PROVIDED HOWEVER, that:

a. The property of this corporation is irrevocably dedicated to charitable purposes, and no part of the net income or assets of this organization shall ever inure to the benefit of any private party or individual; and

b. No substantial part of the activities of this corporation shall be devoted to attempts to influence legislation, by propaganda or otherwise, and the corporation shall not participate or intervene, directly or indirectly, in any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office; and

c. This corporation shall not carry on any activities not permitted to be carried on by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under Section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954, or successor statutes of similar import; and

d. This corporation shall not carry on any activities not permitted to be carried on by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under Section 170 (c) (2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954, or successor statutes of similar import.

SIX: This corporation shall have no members.

SEVEN: In keeping with the charitable purposes to which the property of this corporation is irrevocably dedicated, upon the winding up and dissolution of this corporation, and after payment or adequate provision is made for its debts and obligations, the remaining assets of this corporation shall be distributed to one or more nonprofit funds, foundations, trusts or corporations which are organized and operated exclusively for charitable purposes, and which have established or are entitled to receive tax-exempt status under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954, or successor statutes of similar import.
